

Heritage Open Days Visitor Survey

Terms & Conditions for the Prize Draw

- Draw Date: 20th October 2023
- Entry: The prize draw is open to all residents of the UK over the age of 18, except for employees of the National Trust, Heritage Open Days, their families or anyone else associated with this competition.

Entry to the prize draw is made on successful completion of the survey. Respondents can choose to opt out of the prize draw on completion of the survey if they do not agree with the terms and conditions. In the event that a participant does not qualify to take part in the survey they cannot enter the prize draw.

Surveys completed after the final closing date of 24th September 2023 will not be entered into the prize draw.

- Draw Date: Winners will be drawn at random on the Prize Draw Date
- Prize: The prizes will be awarded as follows: 1x £250 Fortnum and Mason Hamper for one lucky winner. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and not redeemable for cash or any other prize.
